Westchester Medical Center (WMC) is an academic medical center and the flagship hospital of the Westchester Medical Center Health Network. Headquartered in Valhalla, NY, the main campus also includes the Maria Fareri Children's Hospital and a Behavioral Health Center. Our postgraduate year one (PGY1) program builds on Doctor of Pharmacy (PharmD) education and outcomes to develop clinical pharmacists responsible for medication-related care of patients with a wide range of conditions, and who are eligible for board certification and PGY2 pharmacy residency training.

Our residents will gain diverse clinical and operational experience; participate in institutional and departmental committees; attend local, state, and/or national meetings and complete several longitudinal projects and presentations over the course of the program.

Candidates must be a graduate, or graduate candidate, of an ACPE-accredited College of Pharmacy

Candidates must be eligible for New York State (NYS) licensure and employment in NYS

Eligible candidates must submit the following documents via PhORCAS for consideration:

- Curriculum vitae (CV)
- Letter of intent
- Official college transcripts
- Three (3) letters of recommendation from current or previous employers, preceptors, or faculty members

Interview

To ensure a uniform interview process that is equitable for all applications, all interviews will be held virtually.

All candidates will be required to participate in a knowledge-based assessment.
